The HAF programme offers free holiday clubs, activities, and healthy meals during the school holidays.

Who is eligible?

Children must be eligible for, or receiving, benefits-related free school meals.

- Each eligible child can attend up to 12 sessions over the summer
- Places are limited, so early booking is recommended
