

Humans (and other animals) find out about the world using their senses.

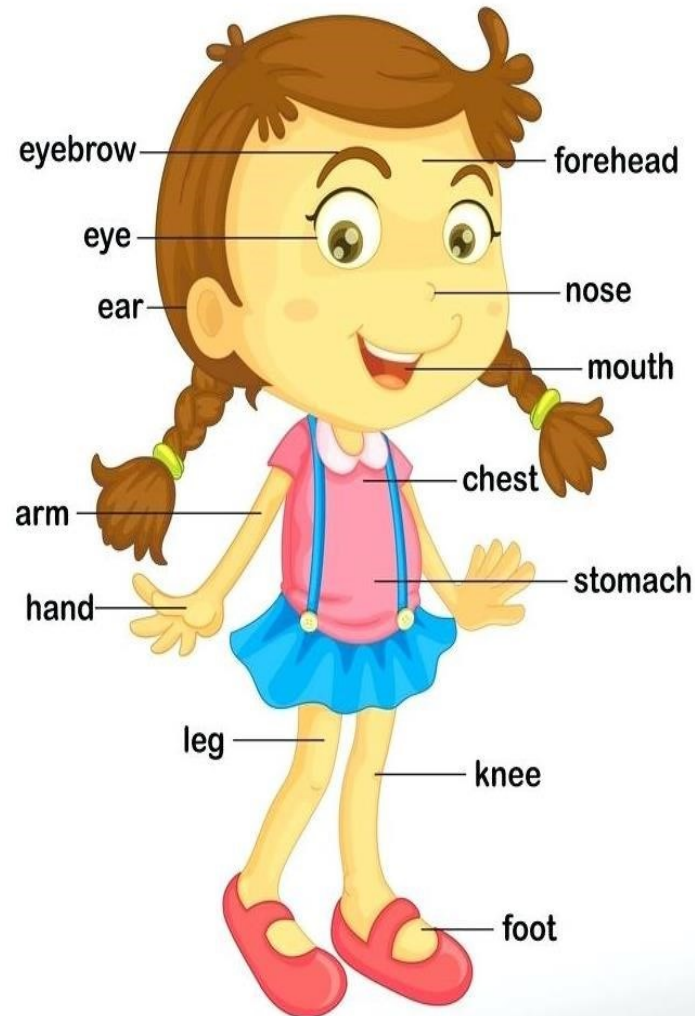
Sense	Body Part

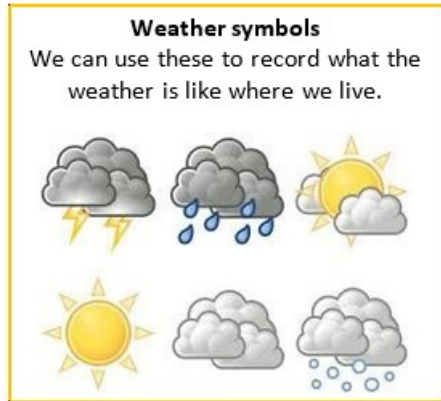

Season	Seasons are periods of similar weather. We have 4 seasons.
Weather	This is how sunny, rainy, windy, snowy etc that it is. It changes with the seasons.
sunrise	The time in the morning when the sun first appears in the sky.
sunset	The time in the evening when the sun disappears out of sight in the sky.

Day length varies according to the season.

In the UK, the day length is the longest in mid-summer (about 16 hours).

Day length gets shorter each day until mid-winter (about 8 hours).

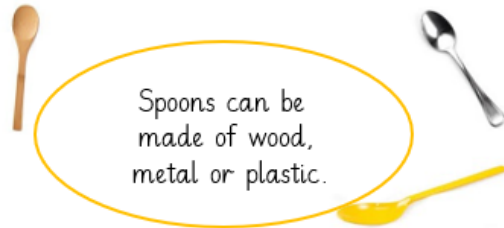


The coldest time of year. Some animals hibernate.

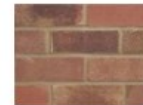

Herbivore	Animals that eat plants	Cow, sheep, rabbit
Omnivore	Animals that eat meat and plants	Human, pig, rat

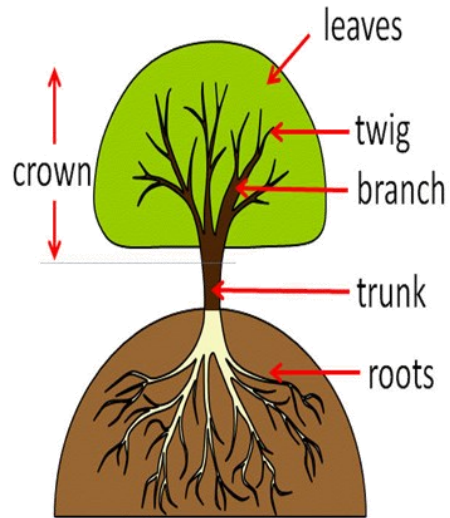
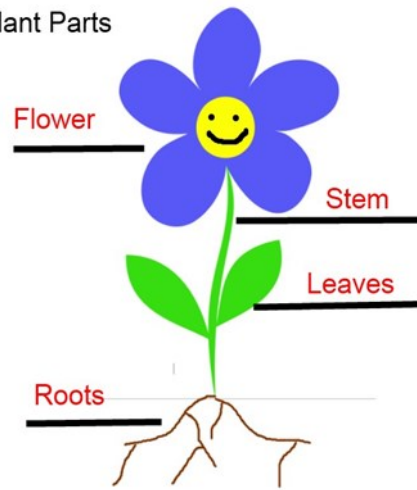

Key Vocabulary and Phrases

Deciduous	a tree that loses its leaves in the autumn every year. Their leaves are generally broad, flat and have veins running through them.
Evergreen	a tree or bush which has green leaves all the year round. Their leaves are generally thick and waxy or have narrow like needles.
Plant	a living thing that grows in the earth and has a stem, leaves, and roots
Roots	the parts of a plant that grow under the ground
Leaf	the parts of a tree or plant that are flat, thin, and usually green
Stem	the thin, upright part of a plant on which the flowers and leaves grow
bulb	a root shaped like an onion that grows into a flower or plant
petal	thin coloured or white parts which form part of the flower
tree	a tall plant that has a hard trunk, branches, and leaves
branches	parts that grow out from the tree trunk and have leaves, flowers, or fruit growing on them
